Guidelines For Entries

- *Open to Town of Barnstable Residents & Property Owners
- *Entries must include an entry form and be delivered and in place at MHF by 5 PM Thursday August 15
- *Entries that do not follow Contest Guidelines will not be accepted.
- *Entries must be picked up after Festival Day by 5 PM Monday August 19.
- *Entries of children under 14 must include parent's signature on entry form.
- *Group Entries Accepted
- *Maximum weight 40 lbs.
- *All sculpture materials must be secure.
- *No unhealthy, dangerous or tasteless materials will be accepted. (sharp glass, needles, cigarette butts.) MHF's discretion
- *Entries can be named or include verbal slogans about reducing litter.

Safety

If you are collecting litter on a busy road wear colorful clothing.

Observe traffic carefully.

Heavily littered areas in West Barnstable are identified as Route 132 near the Burger King Complex and Cape Cod Community College. Also, Osterville West Barnstable Road and Route 149, especially wooded areas.

Category Descriptions

No No NIPs

Sculpture is primarily created from nips.

Did you know?

Nips, small liquor bottles that hold no more than 100 milliliters of alcohol are the most highly littered item in MA. Nip availability undermines efforts to control drinking and driving.

Priceless in Plastic

Sculpture is primarily created from plastic materials.

Did you know?

Trillions of pieces of plastic, many of them microscopic, are floating in the ocean causing damage throughout the food chain.

Anything Goes

Sculpture is created from a variety of common or unique roadside finds.

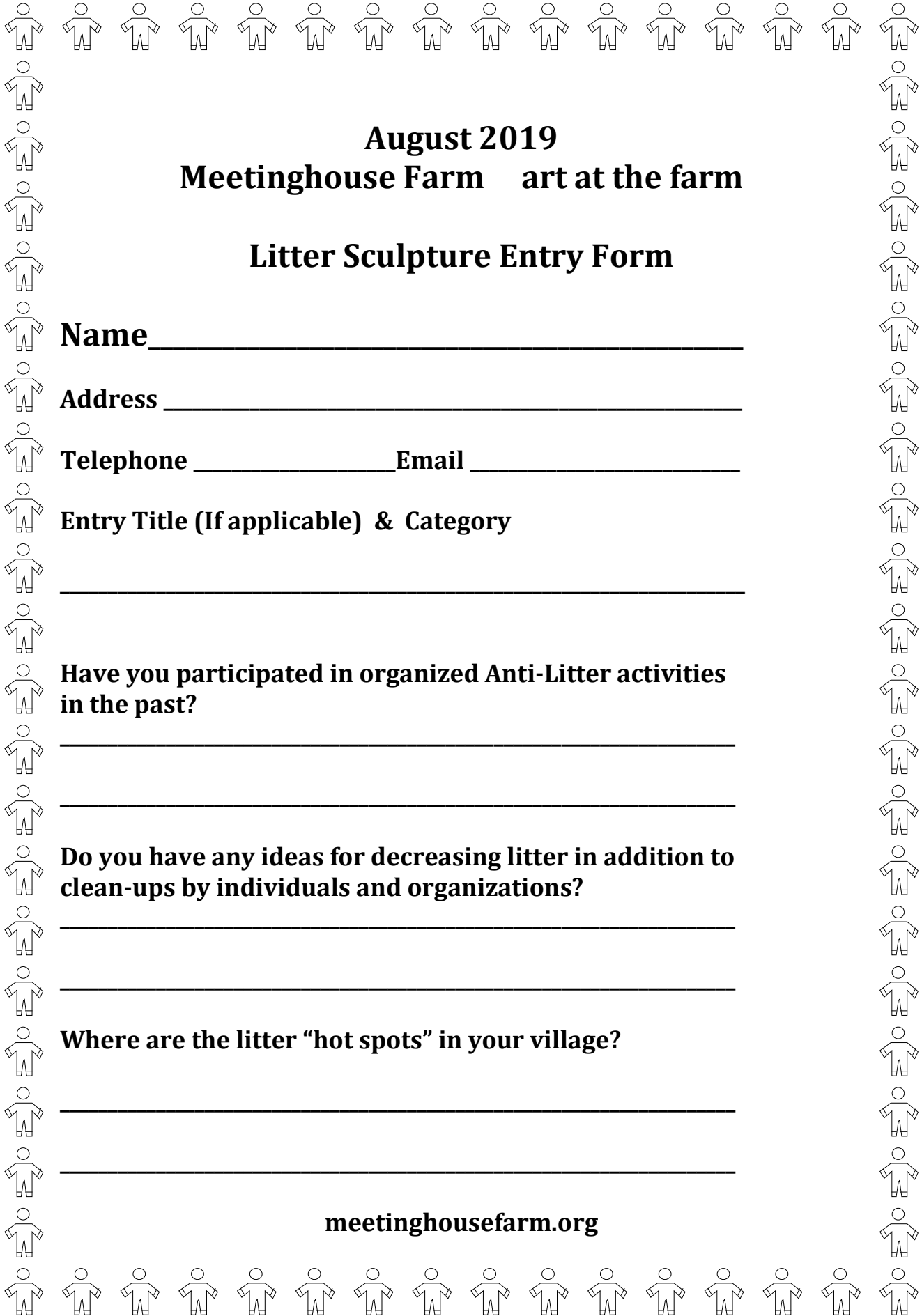
Did you know?
